



2009 JSA / Jefferson Lab Sabbatical/Research Leave Support Program

Introduction. In 1997, the SURA Board of Trustees established the Sabbatical/Research Leave Support Program for SURA university faculty conducting research at the Jefferson Lab during approved sabbatical leave from their home institutions. The Program provides living expense support for researchers to relocate to the Lab during their sabbaticals. This Program has been continued by Jefferson Science Associates (JSA) for qualified faculty members from SURA universities. Support consists of \$1,500 per month for up to twelve months during an approved sabbatical leave. This Program is supported by the JSA Initiatives Fund.

Selection Criteria. An evaluation committee reviews the proposals to assess the potential contributions to the nuclear and related particle physics, accelerator physics and associated fields and the free electron laser research efforts of the Lab. The committee also considers the proposed utilization of the Lab's facilities and the integration with the Lab staff and users to advance the proposed research.
